

PRIVACY POLICY OF DARE TRADING CC. (DARE TRAINING)

Your privacy is important to DARE Trading cc. Dare Trading cc. is publicly known as Dare Training. We will therefore refer to our company in this document as Dare Training. Dare Training is based in Pretoria, South Africa and market our training, consulting and coaching services, Internationally. Our IP is based on and written as a result of:

- research in Education, Neuroscience, Psychology, Health and Wellness;
- professional experience and research of all the members of Dare Training;
- professional experience and research of our collaborative partners.

This privacy policy will explain how Dare Training uses the personal data we collect from you when you use our website or when you trust us with your information to receive emails, get newsletters or to be part of a launch or campaign on social media or to be part of a face book group.

Definitions

Personal Data

Personal Data means data about a living individual who can be identified from those data (or from those and other information either in our possession or likely to come into our possession).

Data Controller

Data Controller means a person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal data are, or are to be, processed.

For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, we are a Data Controller of your data.

Data Processor (or Service Providers)

Data Processor (or Service Provider) means any person (other than an employee of the Data Controller) who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller.

We may use the services of various Service Providers in order to process your data more effectively.

Data Subject

Data Subject is any living individual who is the subject of Personal Data.

User

The User is the individual using our Service. The User corresponds to the Data Subject, who is the subject of Personal Data.

The data we collect.

Our Company collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number)
- When you purchase or attempt to purchase any product or service we collect your name, surname, email address, billing address, payment information (including credit card numbers), telephone number, physical and/or postal address (shipping address), country, region. We refer to this information as "Order Information."
- When you visit our website we automatically collect information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, we collect information about the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms that referred you to the Site, and information about how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as "Device Information."
- When we talk about Personal Information in this Privacy Policy, we are talking both about Device Information and Order Information

How we collect your data.

You directly and completely voluntary provide Dare Training with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or place an order or purchase our products or services.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey, questionnaire or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's **cookies**. Cookies are text files placed on your hard disk of your computer by a web page server and often include an anonymous unique identifier. Through cookies we collect standard Internet log information and visitor behaviour information. Cookies cannot deliver viruses or run programs on your computer. The cookie provides features to save you time by telling the webserver that you have returned to a specific page. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read in a webserver that issued the cookie to you. The cookies simplify the whole process of recording your personal information for billing/ shipping / buying purposes.

Examples of Cookies we use:

- Session Cookies. We use Session Cookies to operate our Service.
- Preference Cookies. We use Preference Cookies to remember your preferences and various settings.
- Security Cookies. We use Security Cookies for security purposes.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies. Your browser or internet device may allow you to delete, disable, or block certain cookies and other tracking technologies. You can choose to enable or disable these options, within the settings of your device but certain aspects and features of our services and sites are only available through the use of cookies, so if you choose to disable or decline cookies, your use of the sites and services may be limited or not possible.

- Tracking technologies also used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Service.

How we will use your data.

Dare Training collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order and manage your account (including processing your payment information, and providing you with invoices and/or order confirmation);
- In line with your preferences you have showed us, provide you with information about special offers, or products and services of Dare Training, or our collaborative partners, you might be interested in;
- Communicate with you via emails, newsletters, blogs or an exclusive face book community;
- Screen our orders for potential risk or fraud (in particular, your IP address)
- use the Device Information that we collect to help us improve and optimize our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns).
- Dare Training sometimes use information from cookies to share some limited aspects of this data with third parties for advertising purposes. We may also share online data collected through cookies with our advertising partners. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website.

We share your Personal Information with third parties to help us use your Personal Information, as described above. For example, we use ParetoCart to power our online store and Google Analytics to help us understand how our customers use the Site

As a general policy, we use personal identifiable information and message data for internal purposes only. We do not sell or rent information about you. We will not disclose personal identifiable information or message data to third parties without your consent, except as explained in this Privacy Policy.

Dare Training cooperates with government and law enforcement officials to enforce and comply with the law. We may therefore disclose personal information, usage data, message data, and any other information about you, if we deem that it is reasonably necessary to: (a) satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process (such as a subpoena or court order), or enforceable governmental request; (b) enforce the Terms of Use, including investigation of potential violations thereof; (c) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues; or (d) protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of Dare Training, its users or the public, as required or permitted by law.

You have the right at any time to stop Dare Training from contacting you for marketing purposes or giving your data to members of our partner companies by Contacting us.

How we will store your data and security of data

If you have an account, you generally may review and edit personal information and data by logging in and updating the information directly or by contacting us.

Dare Training will keep your name, email address and telephone number and update your information according to our communication with you for as long as it is necessary to provide you with relevant information, until you ask us to delete your information. When you place an order through the Site, we will maintain your Order Information for our records unless and until you ask us to delete this information.

- Payment information is provided directly to our third-party payment processors whose use of your personal information is governed by their Privacy Policy. These payment processors adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discovery. PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of payment information.
- The payment processors we work with are **PayFast and Paypal.**

Dare Training will also retain Device Information for internal analysis purposes. Device Information is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our Service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Dare Training securely stores your personal information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment. Your personal identifiable information is protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure.

The servers that store personal information of the NBI questionnaires are hosted at a Tier ivdata centre (underground) with no physical access. Logical security is maintained by a firewall managed by BCX's data specialists.

We maintain technical, physical, and administrative security measures designed to provide reasonable protection for your personal information and data against loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, and alteration. The security measures include firewalls, data encryption, physical access controls to our data centre, and information access authorization controls. When

you purchase a course or product, while we are dedicated to securing our systems and services, you are responsible for securing and maintaining the privacy of your password(s) and account/profile registration information and verifying that the personal data we maintain about you is accurate and current.

The security of your data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Transfer of Data

Your information, including Personal Data, may be transferred to - and maintained on - computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

If you are located outside the United Kingdom and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the data, including Personal Data, to the United Kingdom and process it there.

Additionally, if you are a European resident we note that we are processing your information in order to fulfil contracts we might have with you, or otherwise to pursue our legitimate business interests listed above. Additionally, please note that your information will be transferred outside of Europe, including to Canada and the United States.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

Your data protection rights.

You have the right to request Dare Training for copies of your personal data or to transfer your data that we have collected to another organization, or to you. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

You also have the right to request that Dare Training correct any information you believe is inaccurate or incomplete or to restrict or erase your personal data, or object to processing your personal data under certain conditions.
